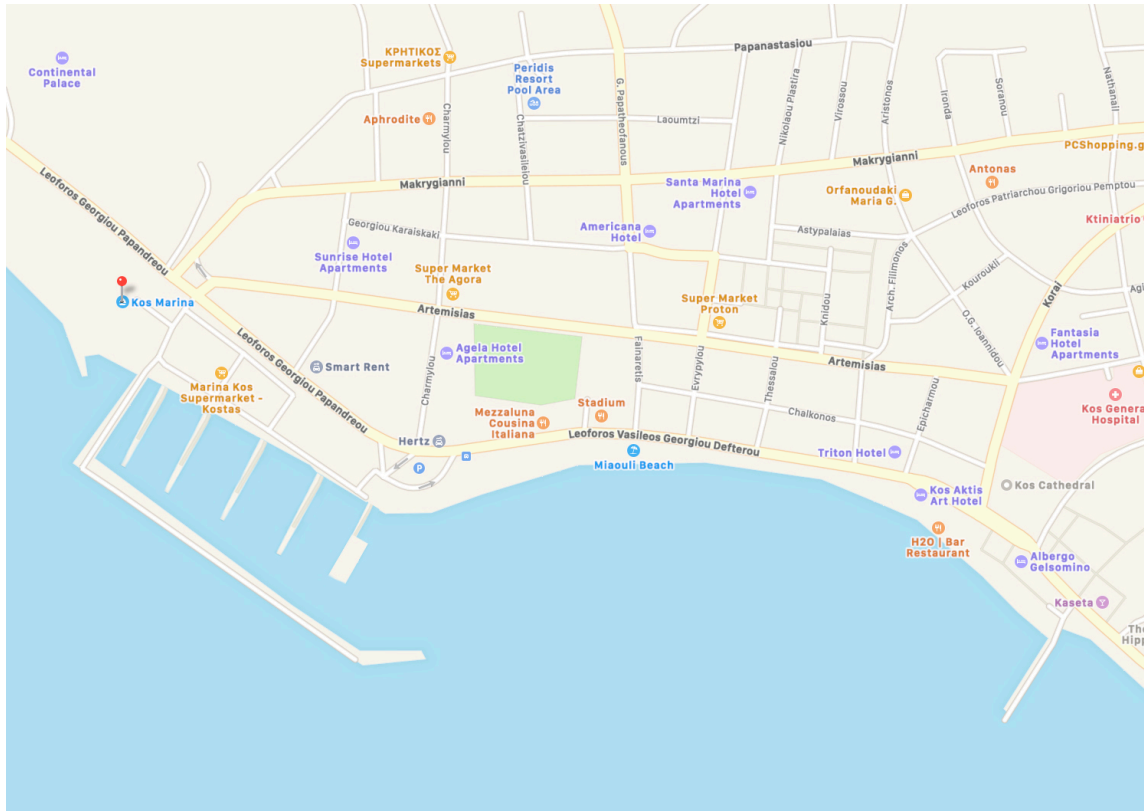

How to get there:

Kos Marina is approximately 20-25m with a taxi ride from the airport which caters to both domestic and international flights.

Moorings:

Berths are situated from both sides of the moles. When returning, a small RIB of the marina will approach you and give instructions. Go stern to or bows to and please do not use your anchor; there are mooring lines.

Provisioning:

Within Kos Marina you will find Super market with fresh fruits & vegetables, Café- Bistro, Restaurant, Laundry, Travel agencies and more. Kos Marina is located in Kos Town. You will find many shops and restaurants, within walking distance from the marina.

Kos Marina

Kos Marina is located one mile SE from Kos old harbour and can hold up to 250 yachts. Many boats from Greece and Turkey moor for a just few days period or all-year-round.

During the summer period most of the shops & restaurants are open all day, throughout the week.

Many quality taverns, restaurants, cafes and bars and ATMs are located within walking distance of the port.

Weather Conditions

Wind force is rather mild thanks Asia Minor coast protecting from E and NE. Wind speeds rarely exceed 6 beauforts (i.e. 25 knots) but tend to remain steady 2-3 beauforts, allowing for more manageable sailing conditions through out the summer period. Particularly in July and August where, Meltemi, the prevailing north wind of that period blow its strongest in Central Aegean Sea, Dodecanese islands remain well protected.

Electricity and Water

At each berth there are special pillars providing 220 volt electricity and water. Your first and last night in the marina are included in the charter price and so is the consumption of water and electricity.

Refueling

You can find refuelling trucks on most islands during your charter. Your last one will take place at Kos Marina, where Eversails staff will help you with the procedure. A truck will be called once you dock. First thing you have to do is check for the truck's fuel meter to be zero. Diesel costs about €1,5/l.
