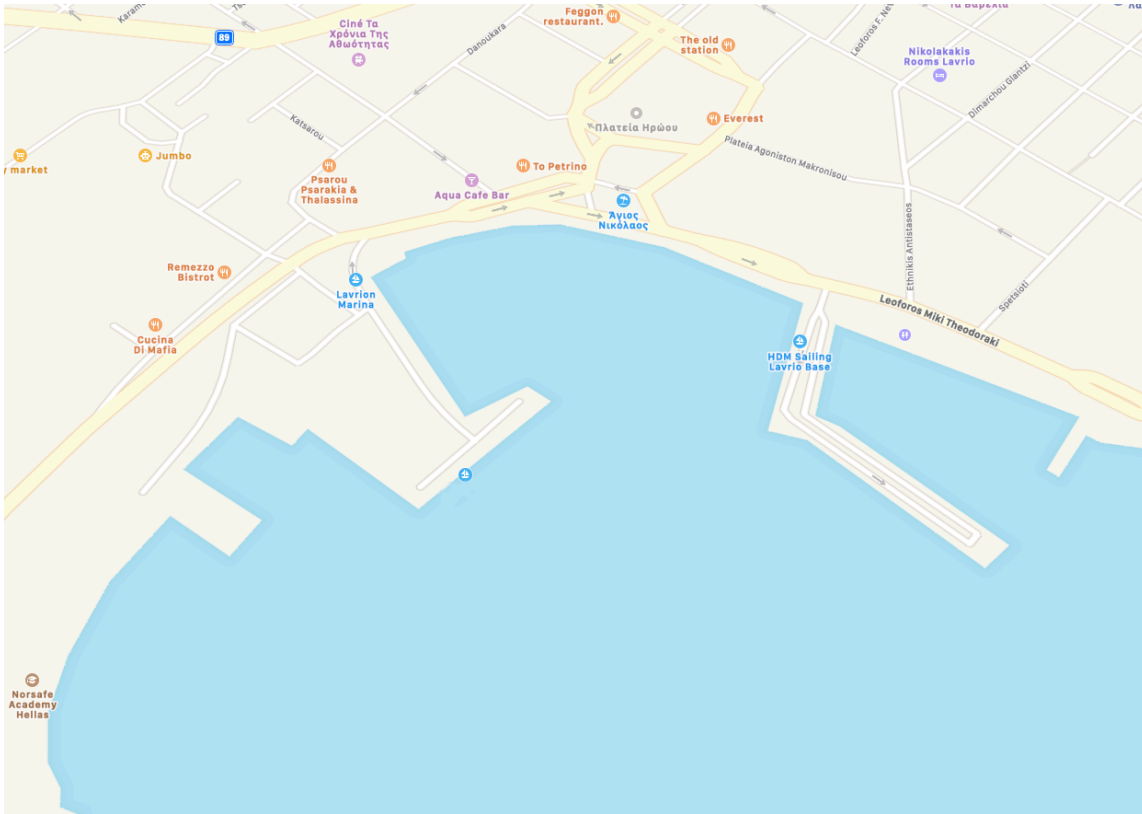

### How to get there:

Lavrion Port can be reached directly from Athens International Airport El. Venizelos. We offer transfer services (taxi, minibus, bus) should you require them. It takes approximately 35-40 minutes to reach Lavrion port from the airport by car.

### Moorings:

Berths are situated from both sides of the L-shaped mole. When returning, go stern to or bows to and please do not use your anchor; there are mooring lines.

### Provisioning:

There are supermarkets near the marina, with delivery service to the yachts. We are happy to assist you with provisioning prior to your arrival.

## Lavrion Port

Lavrion is an excellent starting point for sailing routes in the Cyclades. Within two hours you can reach the first island!

Meeting Point: The reception for check-in is located on the L-shaped mole (in front of the yachts), at our base office.

Electricity and water is provided through pillars. Coffee shops and restaurants in the marina can provide WiFi service.

Many quality taverns, restaurants, cafes and bars and ATMs are located within walking distance of the port.

## Weather Conditions

The prevailing wind in this region is much like that found in the Cyclades, you should expect medium to strong winds, especially during July and August where the 'Meltemi' a local phenomenon with strong N and NE winds takes place, ideal for sailing enthusiast oriented crews.

## Electricity and Water

At each berth there are special pillars providing 220 volt electricity and water. Your first and last night in the marina are included in the charter price and so is the consumption of water and electricity.

## Refueling

You can find refuelling trucks on most islands during your charter. Your last one will take place at Lavrion Port, where Eversails staff will help you with the procedure. A truck will be called once you dock. First thing you have to do is check for the truck's fuel meter to be zero. Diesel costs about €1,5/l.
